3. POTENTIAL HEALTH EFFECTS

ROUTES OF ENTRY: Inhalation – NO Ingestion – YES Contact – YES

ACUTE HAZARD: May be irritation to the eyes, and skin.

CHRONIC HAZARD: No data available.

SIGNS OF OVEREXPOSURE: SKIN – Repeated and prolonged exposure may be irritating to the skin.
EYES – May cause eye irritation. INGESTION – May cause irritation to the mouth, throat and digestive tract.

4. FIRST AID

EYES – Flush with running tap water for at least 15 minutes, if irritation persists seek medical attention.

INGESTION – Do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of water. Call a physician or Poison Control Center.

5. FIRE FIGHTING INSTRUCTIONS

EXTINGUISHING MEDIA: Treat as a solvent fire, CO2, Dry Chemical. Wear protective clothing and self-contained breathing apparatus in all fire conditions.

6. ACCIDENT RESPONSE

SPILLS – Wear protective clothing to prevent contact with spilled material.
CAUTION AREA MAY BE SLIPPERY, SOAK UP SPILL AND WASH THOROUGHLY. Soak up small spills with sand earth or absorbent materials. Scoop up contaminated absorbents and place in trash for disposal in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. Larger spills may be contained with a barrier of sand earth or absorbent materials. Free liquid may be pumped into containers for re-cycling or disposal in accordance with local, state and federal regulations. Residual amounts of material remaining after recovery may be flushed away with large volumes of water.

7. SAFE HANDLING AND STORAGE

Do not ingest – avoid contact with skin and eyes.
Store in a cool dry place. Wash hands thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking or smoking.

8. PERSONAL PROTECTION

VENTILLATION: General room ventilation and local exhaust.
PROTECTIVE GLOVES: Wear rubber or neoprene gloves.
EYE PROTECTION: Safety Goggles.
